#### **Heads or Tails Dating Game**

Looking for a new hot date and don't mind them having fangs or claws? Great! In the Heads or Tails Dating Game, you'll be going onto our game show and asking our contestants questions to determine whether or not they're the right match for you!

#### **Players**

Depending on the amount of players that you're playing with, some small changes can be made for optimal gameplay.

- 3-5 Players: The player who is the Host will also play as a Contestant on the show. After a round of questions have been answered, no players are eliminated.
- 6-10 Players: After each round of questions, the Bachelor will choose a Contestant to eliminate from the show. Eliminated Contestants can no longer answer questions. The goal here is for the Bachelor to eliminate Contestants they feel confident in guessing the identity of.

#### Setup

The player who looks most like a werewolf starts the game as the Host in addition to being a Monster. The player that looks most like a vampire starts the game as the Bachelor. Each Contestant receives 1 monster and 1 personality card at random. They must look at these cards and not reveal their information to anyone else. All players should be made aware of what monsters are options in the game. If a player doesn't like one of their cards, they may put it back for a new one... it's all about having fun!

- Bachelor you're the lucky one looking for love! You'll be the one asking questions and guessing the Contestant identies!
- Contestant a monster contestant. You're given a monster and personality card to act out.
- Host an entertainming role that just means you get to add some fun and life to the game by moderating the rules, announcing the monsters, you know, game show host things! Also, at the end of the round, you'll be able to give 3 points to any Contestant you want for ANY reason.

#### Rules

After the Host announces everyone to the game show (if they wish to), the Bachelor starts the game by asking a question. The question asked is answered in turn by every Contestant, starting with the player left of the Bachelor. It's up to the Contestants to answer the Bachelor's question as best they can with their monster and personality in mind (however, the players don't want to answer in a way that completely gives away their monster).

After 3 rounds of questions have been completed, the Bachelor must make their best guess at each player's monster and personality trait. The Bachelor scores 1 point for each monster they guess correctly, while the monster scores 1 point if the Bachelor guesses incorrectly. If it's deemed by the person left of the monster, that the monster didn't give fair clues to the Bachelor to allow them guess their mosnter correctly, then the Bachelor will score 1 point instead of the monster. Personalities are there to shake things up, but offer no points, so be sure to have fun with them!

Also, last but not least, the Host will be awarding 3 points at the end of each round, so using your monster and personality cards to roleplay will make you more likely to score big - even if it means people figure out what monster you are! That player gets three points. It's up to the Host to play up the fun of the game, drum up excitement, arbitrate rules, and to ultimately decide if the monsters answered their questions fairly. If the Host deems that anyone didn't answer the Bachelor's questions fairly, then the Bachelor will be awarded 1 point for that player, despite not guessing correctly.
